

# AUSTRALIA INDONESIA INVESTOR DIALOGUE BRIEFING

## Introduction

The collaboration between Fitzpatrick & Co Advisory (F&Co) and Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN) has been at the forefront of strengthening Australia-Indonesia economic, business and investment relations. From co-convening high-level investor and business roundtables to coordinating ministerial delegations, our collaboration connect governments, business leaders and institutional investors to unlock new opportunities across critical and future-focused sectors.

The launch of the Australia Indonesia Investor Dialogue (AIID) on 3 September 2025 marks a milestone in this journey – providing a permanent platform to deepen bilateral investment, foster innovation, and accelerate capital flows in areas such as medtech, agtech, critical minerals, AI and infrastructure.

F&Co's track record includes participation in flagship milestones: attendance by F&Co Managing Director Eamonn Fitzpatrick as an Australian delegate to the 2022 B20 and G20 Summit and the 2023 Indo-Pacific Chamber of Commerce and Industry Business Forum in Bali; the launch of the Australian Government's Southeast Asia Economic Strategy to 2040 in Jakarta in 2023; the Australia-ASEAN 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations with President Joko Widodo; attending President Prabowo's inauguration and welcomed Foreign Minister H.E. Sugiono's first official visit to Australia where F&Co hosted an investment delegation program in partnership with KADIN, FIFA Australia, the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade and Business Sydney in March 2025.

## About the Australia Indonesia Investor Dialogue



The establishment of the Australia Indonesia Investor Dialogue (AIID) marks a new era of bilateral business engagement – ushering in a dynamic new platform for deepening commercial ties between two of the Indo-Pacific’s most strategically aligned economies. Bilateral trade reached over A\$20 billion in 2024 with sectors such as agriculture, education, digital services and renewable energy showing robust growth.

The AIID builds on the success of the Indonesia-Australia Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (IA-CEPA), aiming to deepen bilateral economic ties through greater collaboration and investment. With a focus on institutional capital and venture capital, AIID will serve as an accessible bilateral investment platform that allows investors and businesses to transform ideas into impactful opportunities and targeting sectors to drive innovative and economic transformation in both countries.

Designed to foster practical collaborations and unlock new opportunities, AIID will feature a future investment program through a series of strategic panels, keynote events and roundtable discussions involving leaders from government, industry and investment communities from Australia and Indonesia. These activities will be supported by a quarterly AIID investment briefing highlighting key economic trends and opportunities, fostering dialogue and alignment with business chambers, think tanks and research institutions across both countries.

With Indonesia poised to become one of the world’s top five economies by 2045 and Australia seeking to diversify its trade and investment footprint, the AIID isn’t just a timely and strategic initiative, it is a reflection of a shared ambition to move beyond transactional ties toward long-term and values-driven collaboration.

## Australia Indonesia Investor Dialogue launched



The AIID was officially launched on Wednesday 3 September 2025 in Melbourne at the historic Queen's Hall in the Parliament of Victoria.

The launch event featured addresses from leading figures in the Australia-Indonesia bilateral space including: Anindya Bakrie, Shinta Widjaja, Bernardino Vega and AIID co-founders, Eamonn Fitzpatrick, George Marantika and Jack Allen.

During the event's formal proceedings, each speaker reinforced the immense opportunity presented by the formation of Indonesia's trillion-dollar sovereign wealth fund 'Danantara' as well as the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership plan of action 2025-29 between Australia and Indonesia. Speakers and panellists also recognised and reaffirmed AIID's role, which is a dedicated platform for Australian and Indonesian 'captains of capital' (from venture capital and angel investor networks to representatives of the biggest institutional fund managers from across Australia and Indonesia) in working collaboratively in delivering priority access to tangible, actionable investment opportunities in Australia and Indonesia.

The launch event of the AIID also featured a memorandum of understanding signing between KADIN and F&Co led by Bernardino Vega and Eamonn Fitzpatrick, which formally established the framework for a collaborative partnership between both entities with the mutual objective of promoting investment opportunities and strengthening economic ties between Indonesia, Australia and the wider international business community.

For businesses and individuals wishing to seize the moment will be ably guided by the joint expertise of KADIN and F&Co who, as major endorsers of the AIID, will assist AIID stakeholders in identifying, accessing, and effectively executing their investment.

The launch of AIID and MoU signing between KADIN and F&Co was witnessed by convenors of the Victorian Parliamentary Friends of Indonesia Ella George MP and Tom McIntosh MP and supported by the Honourable Natalie Suleyman MP, Minister for Small Business, Minister for Veterans and Minister for Youth of the Parliament of Victoria.
